

FREE SPIRIT ADVENTURES – HOME VALLEY STATION PACKAGE 2012



Day 1 – Arrival and overnight accommodation and hospitality at Home Valley Station Homestead

Guests are transferred from Kununurra to the Station Homestead by road, 55kms along the scenic Great Northern Highway (sealed road) and a further 69kms along the famous Gibb River Road (unsealed road).

On arrival, guests are provided refreshments as their hosts escort each guest to Home Valley's guesthouse accommodation. Time to explore the Homestead surrounds or simply rest on the verandah with a cool drink enjoying views over the idyllic Bindoola Creek. Dinner tonight is in the Dusty Bar & Grill, enjoying authentic Kimberley entertainment.



Day 2 – Morning Fishing Expedition on the Pentecost River & Cambridge Gulf

Breakfast is served within the Dusty Bar & Grill Restaurant prior to a half-day over-water adventure, exploring the mighty Pentecost River and west arm of the Cambridge Gulf. Guests are welcomed aboard an HV8 marine craft to begin their hunt for barramundi or simply to take in the raw beauty of the Kimberley's prolific wildlife. This half-day Guided Tour departs early morning and incorporates a delicious morning tea served at a private and picturesque location.



After returning to the Homestead for lunch it's time for a restful siesta or relaxing by the pool. There are also options to visit Bindoola Gorge for a swim in the rock pools and/or a Champagne Sunset Tour at the private HV8 Lookout where you'll see breathtaking views of the majestic Cockburn Range. Tonight dinner is served at the Homestead's Dusty Bar & Grill. After dinner, guests are treated to bush poetry recitals, live local entertainment by the campfire.

Day 3 – Kimberley Cattle Muster Experience

Enjoy another hearty breakfast as the Kimberley sunrise welcomes another day. Breakfast is followed by a leisurely morning at the Homestead and a Horsemanship Tuition Session with Home Valley's experienced Stockmen.

After a freshly made lunch at the stockyards it is time to get stuck into the real action on horseback where guests participate in an overnight cattle muster experience. As they ride along on horseback mustering the cattle, guests will appreciate the grandeur of the rugged landforms of the valley with its towering escarpments dotted with ancient boabs.

During the muster local Indigenous Drovers will provide guests with an insight into the meaning of their country that the cattle drive passes through, and the link between the "old-time" pastoralists that impacted greatly on their families lives, today holding great pride in what it is like to be known as a Kimberley Stockman.

As the dust settles and the sun sets, guests are invited to set up camp for the evening. This evening's dinner includes a combination of traditional and modern "Bush Tucker" cuisine. All will enjoy a well earned dinner and drinks around a roaring campfire. After dinner guests can retire for the night while listening to the night time calls of the surrounding wildlife and drift into a peaceful sleep under a blanket of Kimberley stars.



Day 4 - Completion of Cattle Muster, return to the Home Valley Station Homestead and Transfer to Kununurra.

This morning guests will awake to the pure beauty of first light offered up in the outback and the sweet smell of Spinifex warming in the sun, not to forget the pleasure of a breakfast being cooked over the campfire. Following breakfast, the team will pack up camp and embark on the completion of their cattle muster experience; returning to Home Valley Homestead in time for an early lunch before being transferred by 4WD to Kununurra – airport for the flight back to Darwin.
